An Affected Party who is interested in participating at the Informal Formal Quasi-Judicial hearing is required to complete a Registration Card in the form prescribed by the decision making body prior to the start of the hearing, in accordance with Chapter 4, Article XII §12.12.02 within the Laws of Cedar Key. The definition of the term "Affected Party" is set forth in §12.12.02.

If any person decides to appeal the decision of the Historic Board with respect to any matter considered at said Public Hearing, that person will need to ensure that a verbatim record of the proceedings is made, which includes the testimony and evidence upon which the Appeal is to be based.
