

**LAST DAY TO REGISTER TO VOTE FOR  
2026 MUNICIPAL ELECTIONS  
MARCH 9, 2026**

To be eligible to vote in the **City of Cedar Key** or **Town of Inglis** Election, you must submit a completed **Florida Voter Registration Application** by **March 9, 2026**. When voter registration books close for a General Election, updates to a voter's name, party, address, and signature are still permitted, in accordance with Florida Statutes 98.055, 98.077, and 101.045.

**HAS YOUR SIGNATURE CHANGED?**

If your signature has changed, please update it as soon as possible. Signatures can vary over time due to aging or medical conditions. Any significant change to your signature or identifying mark should be updated with our office to ensure your ballot and documents can be verified.

Paper voter registration applications are also available at your local elections office, public libraries, and authorized locations issuing fishing, hunting, or trapping permits through the Florida Fish and Wildlife Conservation Commission.
