

**EXTENSION OF DECLARATION OF EMERGENCY  
CITY OF CEDAR KEY, FLORIDA  
HURRICANE IDALIA**

Whereas, Governor DeSantis, on August 26, 2023, issued Executive Order 23-171, which order declares a state of emergency in the State of Florida, including Levy County; and

Whereas, the Mayor of the City of Cedar Key, Florida, under §2.08.01-.09 of the Laws of Cedar Key and the City's Comprehensive Emergency Management Plan, issued a Declaration of Emergency; and

Whereas, pursuant to Fla. Stat. §252.38(4), the Mayor's Declaration of Emergency expires in seven days if not extended by the City Commission;

Now, Therefore, the City Commission of the City of Cedar Key does hereby extend the original Declaration of Emergency by seven days, to September 12, 2023.
