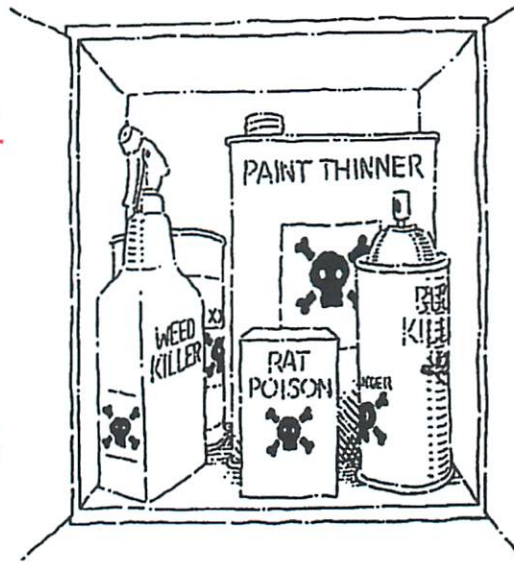

## What to Bring

Unneeded household hazardous waste in sealed containers (original when possible).

- Oil Based Paints
- Stains, Thinners & Strippers
- Solvents & Varnishes
- Adhesives, Glues, Resins
- Waste Fuels (Kerosene, Gasoline)
- Engine Degreaser, Brake Fluid
- Transmission Fluid
- Poisons, Insecticides, Weed Killers
- Wood Preservatives
- Hobby Supplies, Artist Supplies
- Photo Chemicals, Chemistry Sets
- Cleaners, Spot Removers
- Swimming, Pool Chemicals
- Dry Cell Batteries
- Aerosol Cans
- Pesticides
- NiCad Batteries
- Hearing Aid (Button) Batteries
- Used Motor Oil
- Propane Tanks
- Tires
- Electronics

## What NOT to Bring

- Asbestos
- Smoke Detectors
- Compressed Gas Cylinders
- Ammunition, Fireworks, Explosives
- Commercial or Industrial Waste
- Infectious & Biological Waste
- Radioactive Waste
- Fire Extinguishers

## To Ensure Safety, Please:

- Tighten caps and lids leaving materials in original labeled containers.
- Pack containers in sturdy upright boxes and pad with newspaper.
- Sort and pack separately: Paint, pesticides, household cleaners.
- NEVER MIX CHEMICALS!!
- Pack your vehicle and go directly to the site. NEVER SMOKE while handling hazardous materials.
- DO NOT place waste in a garbage bag .
